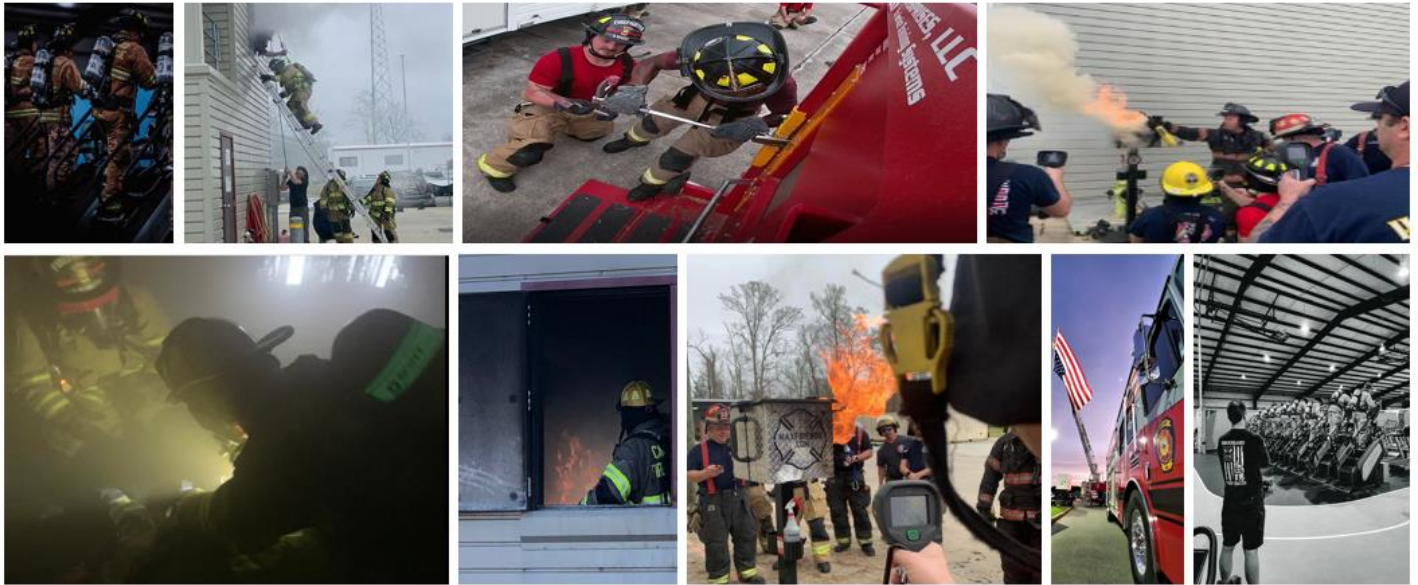

Incredibly, another year has come and gone since we last updated you on our progress. This year has been an amazing year of growth for our department and our community. At Broussard Fire Department we strive to provide expedient, reliable, fire protection and medical services to our community. We know we can count on you, our community, to help support our efforts, by contributing financially. At Broussard Fire Department training our volunteers and staff is a priority. We train as if our life depends on it because it does. We know, in an emergency, “We don’t rise to the level of our expectations; we fall to the level of our training.”— Archilochus. Every call is unpredictable, we never know what we will face until we arrive. We provide multiple training opportunities and expect our members to train hard in an effort to be prepared for any situation. In 2021, BFD individual members tested and earned 28 new certifications. As a group, we logged over 1,500 hours of combined training.



Utilizing 34 part-time employees and 25 volunteer firefighters, Broussard Fire Department responded to 981 incidents in 2021 with an average of 11 firefighters per incident. Our average response time, of the first arriving unit within the city limits, was four minutes, twenty-five seconds. These records prove we are surpassing our goals to provide expedient, reliable, fire protection, and first response emergency medical services to our community.

Our fire rating holds at a Class 3, according to the Property Insurance Association of Louisiana. This affects our homeowner's premiums favorably. Our rating year is in full swing, rest assured, we are doing everything in our power to improve that score this year.
